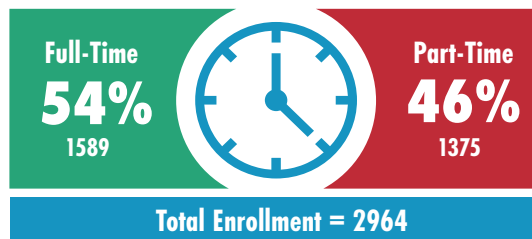

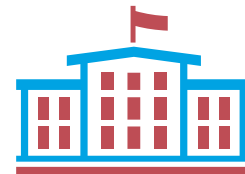

Unduplicated Enrollment AY25³



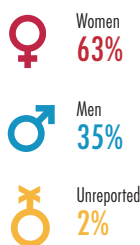
Headcount Fall 2024¹

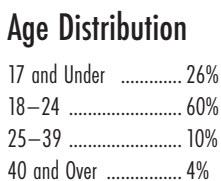

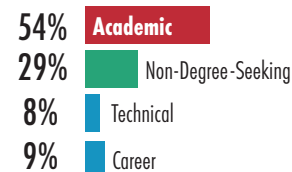
