## RESIDUAL ACT TEST INFORMATION

If you need a higher ACT score to enroll in MDCC or to qualify for scholarships, the ACT will be given on a residual basis on **March 26, 2024** in the Stanny Sanders Library on the Mississippi Delta Community College Moorhead campus beginning at **8:30 a.m.** The cost is \$63.00, payable in advance. Please complete the form below and bring it with **cash** or a **money order** made payable to Mississippi Delta Community College.

- 1. This money is **non-refundable** or **transferable** if you do not come on your scheduled date. Test supervisors and proctors are hired based on the number scheduled.
- 2. No further notification will be mailed to you concerning your registration.
- 3. No walk-ins will be allowed on the date of testing.
- All examinees must provide proof of identification on the date of the test (something with a photograph, i.e., driver's license, ID card or MDCC student ID). THOSE WITHOUT THIS IDENTIFICATION WILL NOT BE TESTED.
- 5. You may bring a calculator for use on the mathematics test.
- 6. The test will last approximately four (4) hours. Do not bring children or other guests. We will not be able to accommodate them.
- 7. Tests on a **residual** basis can be taken **only once** every 60 days. Taking the ACT on a residual basis within 60 days will result in forfeiture of registration fee as well as cancellation of scores. You **are** eligible to take the ACT if you previously had the test on a **national** testing date.
- 8. We reserve the right to change your test date if we become overcrowded. We only have a limited number of test booklets.
- 9. This residual ACT is good only for those seeking admission to Mississippi Delta Community College. It is not transferable to another institution.
