### Admission Requirements

Students must submit a composite score of 16 or higher on the ACT or Accuplacer scores of Reading, 55; Pre-Algebra Math, 34; OR Next Generation Accuplacer scores of Reading, 239; Math 215. Students who are returning to the program after an absence of a semester or more must graduate under the current catalog requirements.
